Ps. Terry Calkin gave four points from Pastor Wilbur Wright:

Four Points

1. A passion to fulfil the great commission
2. In each nation the ministry is best led by gifted, dedicated national leadership
3. A vital key is to build strong relationships with the national leadership for shared vision and mutual trust
4. The most strategic contribution is in the area of leadership training

Read again the verses Ps. Paul Anslow read on Sunday morning.

Matt. 9 v 35 to 38

Find other verses with the same implications.

- Has anything changed since the time of Jesus' word in these verses?
- If so what has changed?
- What does it mean to "Ask the Lord of the harvest"?
- Do these words have any impact on your desire to obey His request?

Discuss as a group how you would respond to such a request.

Matt.28 v 16 to 20

This is a personal call to His followers.

- Do you believe this to be true?

Take each phrase of Jesus' words and discuss what they mean to you.

Act 1 v 8 Has some significant information in regards to missions.

Discuss what these are and how they should be applied.

Questions:

- Have you ever responded to a call to serve on a mission at home or overseas?

Discuss with your group how it came about and what happened.

Share in what ways have you been blessed by serving on a mission.

- What opportunities would you like to see for missions?

Discuss things the church leadership could do to help you get involved.
